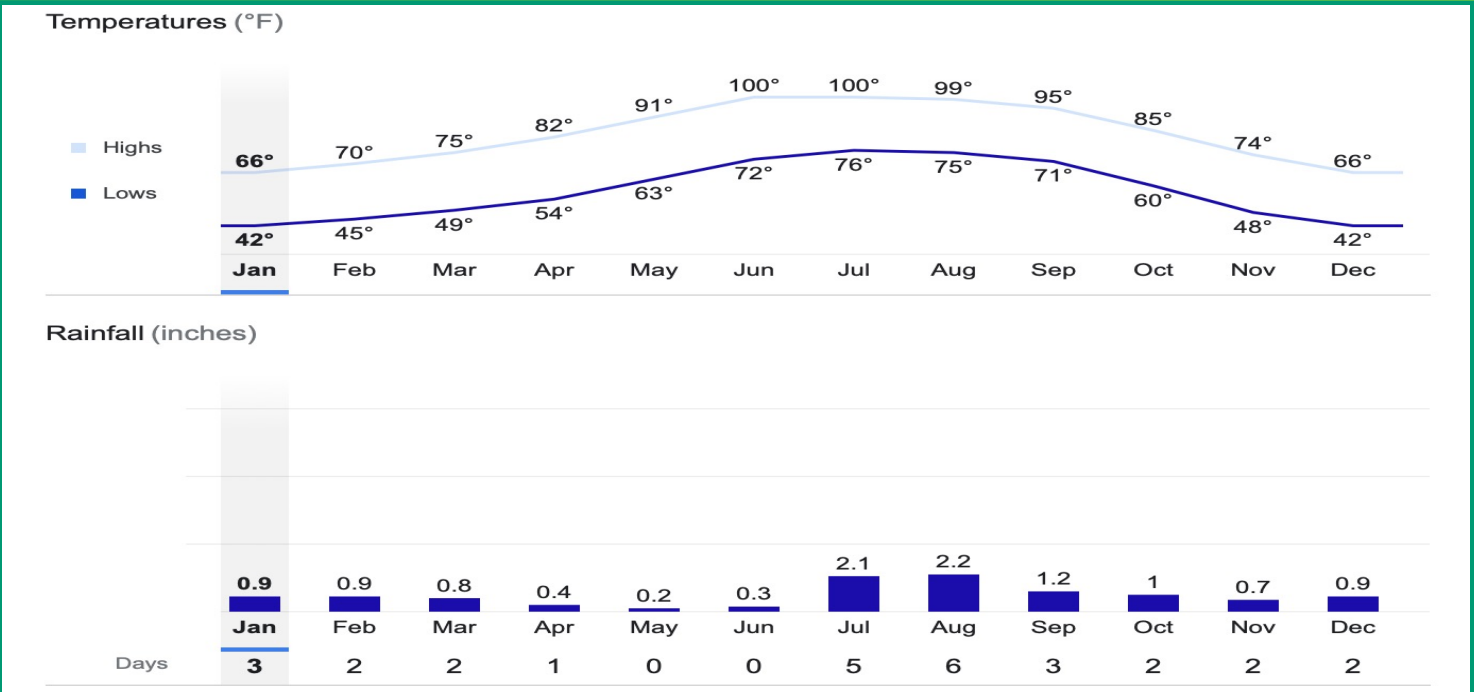

• 4-Man Scramble (18) from White Tees

Surrounded by towering saguaro cacti and Tucson's majestic Tortolita Mountains, The Golf Club at Dove Mountain offers players challenges amid Arizona's distinct natural beauty. The club's three 9-hole courses (Saguaro, Tortolita & Wild Burro), each designed by Jack Nicklaus, provide 27 holes of championship golf with surroundings and changing elevation yielding variety to each round of play. The course setup used for the Accenture Match Play tournament tallied 7,849 yards with a course rating of 77.1 and a slope of 147. Be happy it's a scramble!

Arizona National Golf Club, designed by Robert Trent Jones Jr, was voted best public golf course in Tucson, Arizona. Nestled in the foothills of the beautiful Santa Catalina Mountains and abutting the Coronado National Forest, Arizona National provides a diverse 6,785-yard layout with golf-in-the-desert challenges that might test your golfing limits. And as compensation for the challenge, you'll get to enjoy some of the most spectacular scenery of any golf course in the Southwest Tucson Arizona area, including panoramic mountain vistas, forests of giant saguaros, and the rare beauty of nine natural springs. From the tips, the course rating is 72.2 with a 139 slope.

Starr Pass Country Club – Rattler / Roadrunner

- *Day 3*
 - *C&S Cup 2 Man Best Ball (18)*

Starr Pass Golf Club hosted the annual Tucson Open between 1987 and 1996. During that time, the third (#3 Rattler) and fifth holes (#5 Rattler) were rated two of the most difficult on the PGA Tour, with the average score for 18 holes ranking among the highest on tour as well. A true desert course, natural elements are used as hazards while showcasing majestic vistas of the Catalina Mountains. Legends such as Arnold Palmer, Phil Mickelson, Payne Stewart, and Nancy Lopez have carved their way through this historic golf course. The Rattler and Roadrunner both offer unsurpassed views with dramatic elevation changes and the swirling winds created by the Tucson Mountains truly test players of all levels. From the tips, the course rating is 71.7 with a 142 slope.



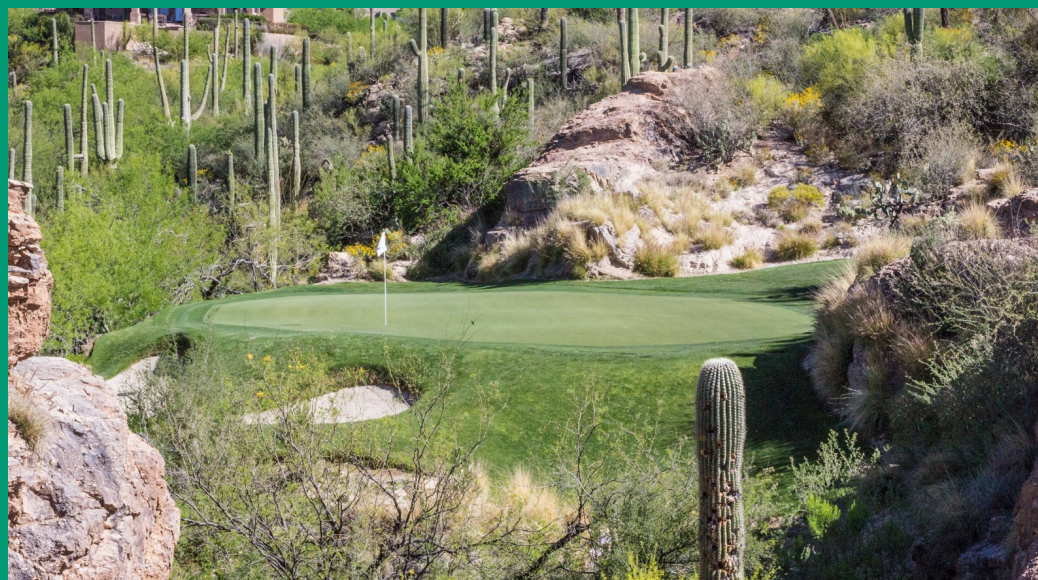

 - C&S Cup Individuals (18)


Voted Best Golf Resort course in Arizona by Golfweek Magazine, Tom Fazio's two 18-hole championship courses (Catalina and Mountain) provide tee boxes surrounded by the beautiful Catalina mountain views, fairways rich with regional flora and fauna and putting greens that glimmer against the dunes behind them. The impeccably kept grounds and commitment to service reflect the true essence of Ventana Canyon Golf, which has earned the title of best in the country on multiple occasions. The Mountain course measures 6,898 yards in length from the Championship tees and plays to a par 72 with a course rating of 72.8 and a slope of 143.

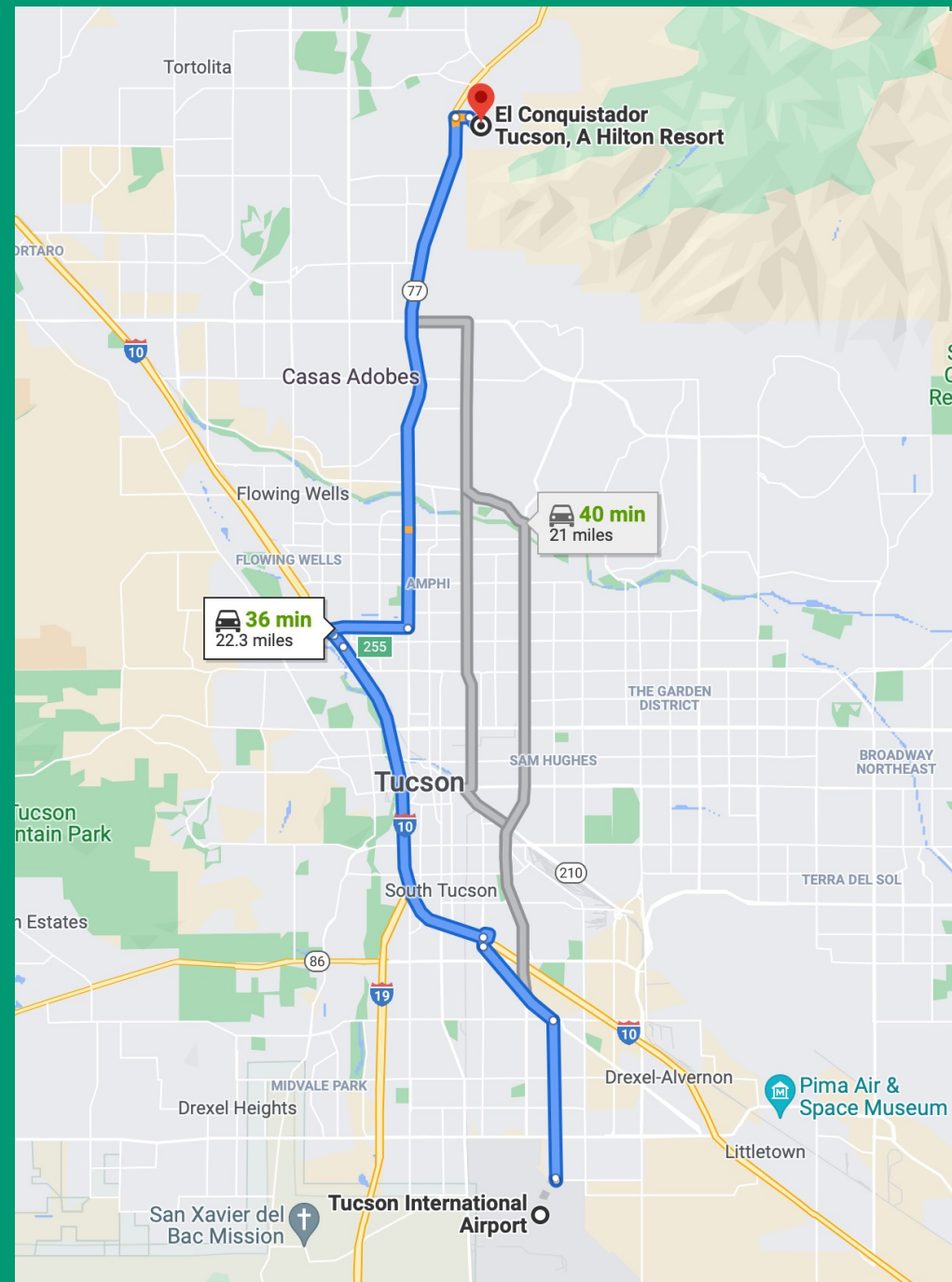

Getting to Your Destination

- 1) If not already on, turn on smart phone
 - 1) Important, if battery charge is low, plug it into car charger.
- 2) Call up Google Maps (or any decent GPS navigation system)
- 3) Put in one of the following destinations –
 - a) **The GC at Dove Mountain at 6501 W Boulder Bridge Pass, Marana, AZ 85658**
 - b) **Arizona National GC at 9777 E Sabino Greens Dr, Tucson, AZ 85749**
 - c) **Starr Pass Golf Club at 3645 W Starr Pass Blvd, Tucson, AZ 85745**
 - d) **Ventana Canyon GC at 6200 N. Club House Lane, Tucson, AZ 85750**
 - e) **El Conquistador Tucson at 10000 N Oracle Rd, Tucson, AZ 85704**
- 4) Use your current location as the starting point
- 5) Do the search, and follow the directions
 - a) Note that this same process can be used for other destinations

Important - The Dove Mountain golf venue is around 45 minutes from the airport

Important – If you take a wrong turn and end up in Mexico, you're on your own – adios, amigos.



C & S / PGA Tournament 'Partnering' Contest



Prior to the start of the Valero Texas Open in San Antonio, TX, each contestant will select a player from the PGA field to be his 'partner'. PGA players that are ranked in the top 25 of the world rankings can't be selected. The contest will include the Thursday, Friday and Saturday rounds of the PGA and the Corn & Soda Cup. Each day, the contestants C&S points earned/lost will be combined with the PGA player's score compared to par to arrive at the '2 man team' score for that day.

Examples:

Tan Man selects Kevin Na who shoots -2 in the opening round of the Valero while Tan Man wins one match and ties one match in the Thursday 2-man better ball. -2 minus 1 = -3 (Tan Man's score for Thursday)

Sticks selects Marc Leishman who shoots $+3$ in the second round of the Valero while Sticks loses both matches in the 2-man best ball on Friday. $+3$ plus 2 = $+5$ (Sticks's score for Friday)

Low score for the 3 day total wins. 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places are paid. (50%, 30% & 20% of pot) (\$160, \$96, \$72) - \$20 entry fee.

Note: If the PGA player selected does not make the cut, that C&S player is eliminated.
