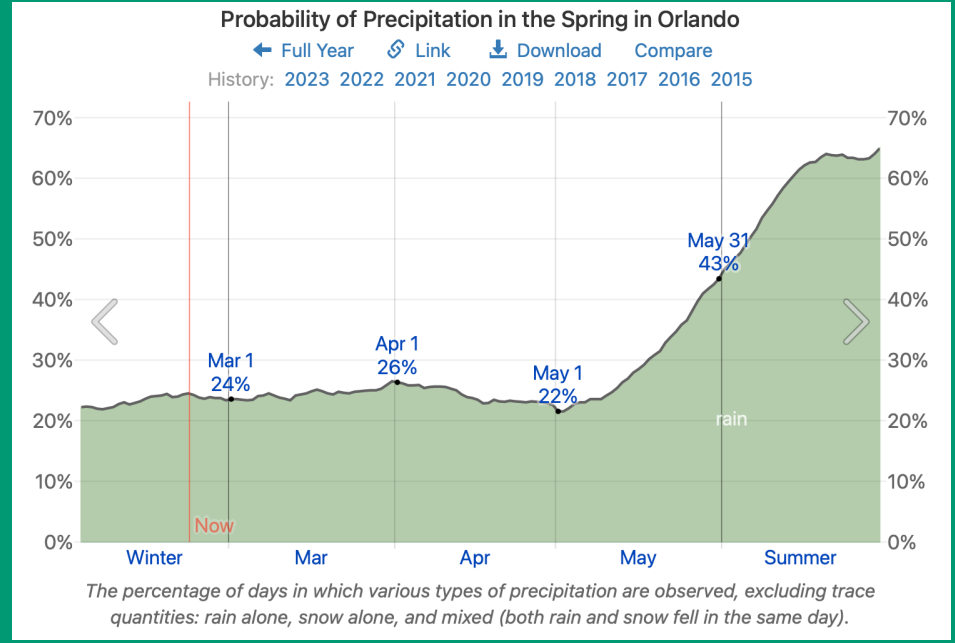
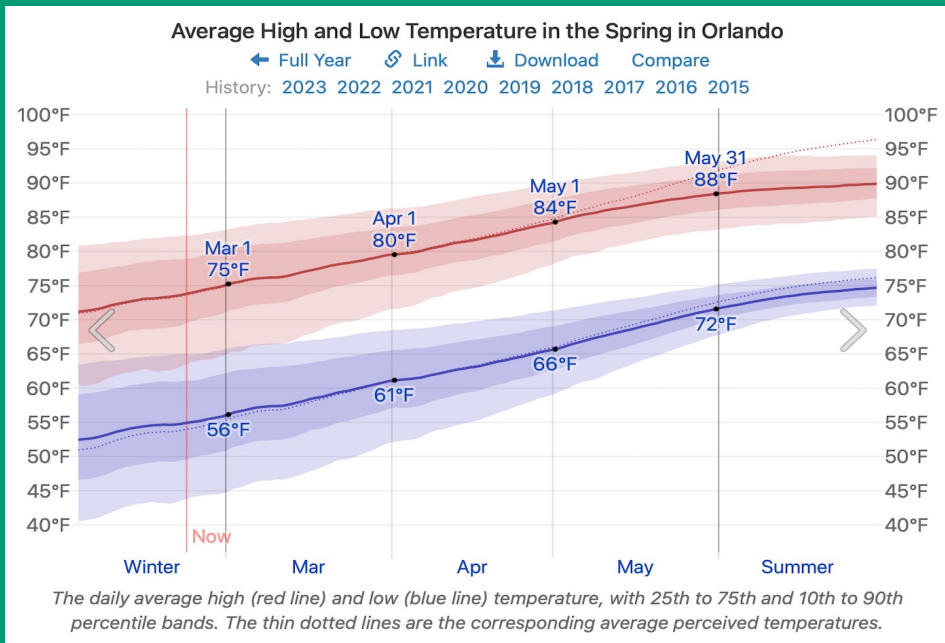

This design delivers a golfing experience that can challenge the pros and yet offers a rewarding time for all. Robert Trent Jones put it like this, “With the beauty of the course, the design...everyone will have fun because it can be enjoyed here on many levels.” Celebration Golf Club has hosted events such as the U.S. Senior Open Qualifier and The Golf Channel’s Drive, Chip and Putt Finals. From the tips, it’s 6,757 yards with a course rating of 73.1 and a slope of 141. No worries, it’s a scramble!

Designed by Rees Jones, Falcon's Fire Golf Club features a blend of modern and classic architecture. Measuring 7,006 yards from the championship tees, Falcon's Fire Golf Club boasts a course rating of 73.2 and slope of 135. Voted 4 stars by Golf Digest's Places to Play, Falcon's Fire Golf Club in Orlando continually receives worldwide recognition for the quality of its overall golf experience.



In 2001, C&S played this course so this will be only the 4th time in 37 years that a C&S event has returned to play another round at a course!

The Links Course – Grand Cypress GC at Evermore Resort

- *Day 3*
 - *C&S Cup 2 Man Best Ball (18)*

Set in the midst of an open meadow landscape, with features such as steeper and more challenging bunkers and rolling slopes, this unique course is Jack Nicklaus' tribute and homage to the famed Old Course at St. Andrews, Scotland. This Scottish links masterpiece is complete with double greens, stone bridges and walls, gorse mounds, meandering burns, pot bunkers, plus natural bunkers as deep as 12 feet - all in the spirit of the true Scottish original. Very little water comes into play, but when it does players will be quite challenged. Very few trees are located within the interior of the course, creating generous landing areas, but beware the over 150 pot bunkers around the course. From the tips, the course is 6,773 yards with a course rating of 71.9 and a 121 slope.

Shingle Creek Golf Club

- *Day 4*
- *C&S Cup Individuals (18)*


Shingle Creek Golf Club came onto the Orlando golf scene in December 2003, with an 18-hole championship facility originally designed by David Harman. Redesigned by Arnold Palmer Golf Design in Summer 2016, Shingle Creek features undulating fairways, interconnecting waterways, tournament playing conditions daily, and large, rolling greens. A feeling of nature abounds as dense oaks and pines provide a backdrop along historic Shingle Creek. Shingle Creek Golf Club topped the list as the Best Golf Course in Orlando in 2021. The 7,228-yard course has a course rating of 75.1 and a slope of 139.

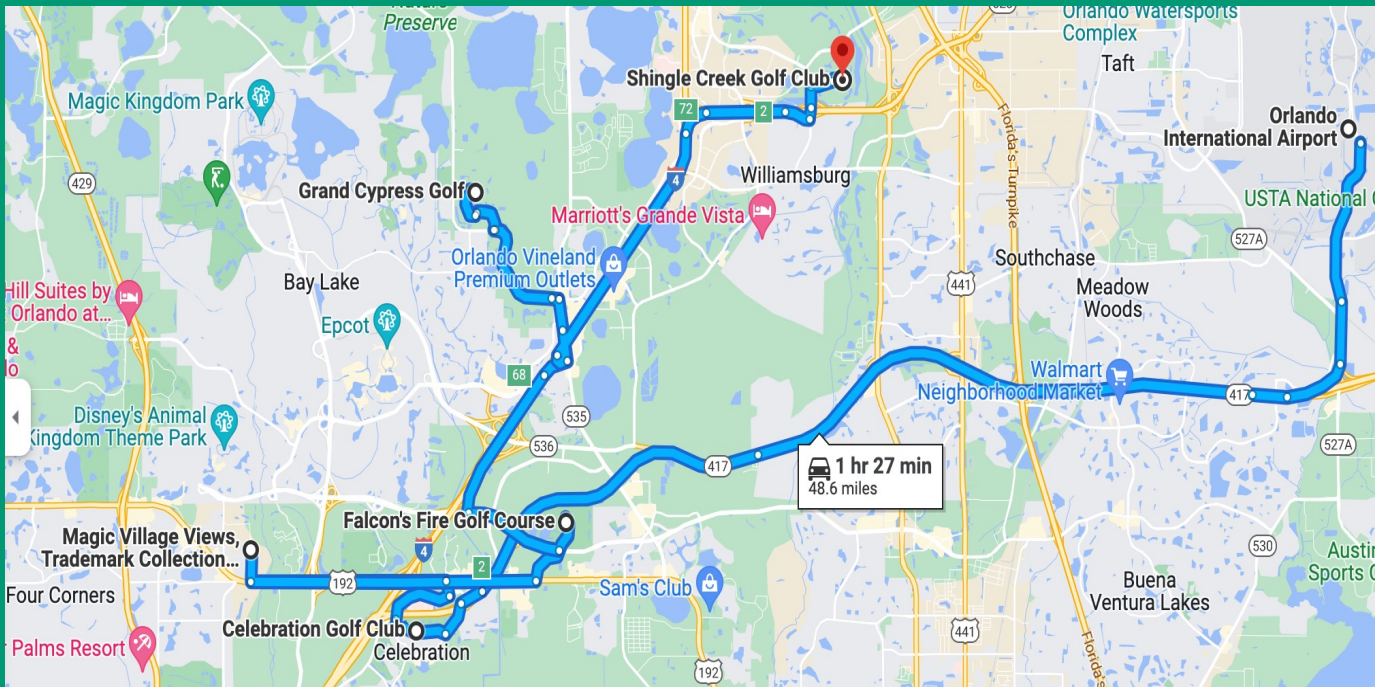

Getting to Your Destination

- 1) If not already on, turn on smart phone
 - 1) Important, if battery charge is low, plug it into car charger.
- 2) Call up Google Maps (or any decent GPS navigation system)
- 3) Put in one of the following destinations –
 - a) **Celebration Golf Club at 701 Golfpark Dr, Celebration, FL 34747**
 - b) **Falcon's Fire GC at 3200 Seralago Blvd, Kissimmee, FL 34746**
 - c) **The Links Course – Grand Cypress GC at Evermore Resort at 1 N Jacaranda St, Orlando, FL 32836**
 - d) **Shingle Creek GC at 9939 Universal Blvd, Orlando, FL 32819**
 - e) **Magic Views Vacation Resort at 7430 Brooklyn Dr, Kissimmee, FL 34747**
- 4) Use your current location as the starting point
- 5) Do the search, and follow the directions
 - a) Note that this same process can be used for other destinations....duh



Important - The Celebration golf venue is around 25 minutes from the airport (ignore the 1 hr 27 min indicator which is if you were to drive to all 4 courses and the resort in one trip)

Important – If you take a wrong turn and end up in The Villages, bring protection.

C & S / PGA Tournament 'Partnering' Contest



Prior to the start of the Valero Texas Open in San Antonio, TX, each contestant will select a player from the PGA field to be his 'partner'. PGA players that are ranked in the top 25 of the world rankings can't be selected. The contest will include the Thursday, Friday and Saturday rounds of the PGA and the Corn & Soda Cup. Each day, the contestants C&S points earned/lost will be combined with the PGA player's score compared to par to arrive at the '2 man team' score for that day.

Examples:

Tan Man selects Tiger Woods who shoots -2 in the opening round of the Valero while Tan Man wins one match and ties one match in the Thursday 2-man better ball. -2 minus 1 = -3 (Tan Man's score for Thursday)

Sticks selects Scott Stallings who shoots $+3$ in the second round of the Valero while Sticks loses both matches in the 2-man best ball on Friday. $+3$ plus 2 = $+5$ (Sticks's score for Friday)

Low score for the 3 day total wins. 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places are paid. (50%, 30% & 20% of pot) (\$120, \$72, \$48) - \$20 entry fee.

Note: If the PGA player selected does not make the cut, that C&S player is eliminated.
