

## Chimera Golf Club – Henderson, NV

- Day 1
  - 4-Man Scramble (18) from Blue Tees for par 4s and Black for all others

The Chimera Golf Club was designed in 2003 by Ted Robinson Jr. The layout boasts forgiving fairways and a playable desert landscape which provides a fair challenge from any set of tees. The natural terrain and unparalleled views of the Las Vegas Strip make Chimera Golf Club an incredible place to enjoy a round. In 2018, C&S played this course so this is only the 5<sup>th</sup> time in 38 years that a C&S event has returned to play another round at a course! At 6,757 yards from the back tees, this is the shortest of the 4 courses we are playing with a course rating of 71.8 and a slope of 124. So enjoy and take advantage of it. No worries, it's a scramble!

## Sand Hollow GC, Championship Course – Hurricane, UT

- *Day 2* 
  - C&S Cup 2-man Best Ball (18)

Nestled in the southwest desert landscape, the Sand Hollow Resort Championship Course takes full advantage of the region's natural beauty. Ranked the #1 "Best Course You Can Play" in Utah since 2009, Southern Utah's incredible views and engulfing vistas surround the front nine's red rock outcroppings, natural vegetation, indigenous sand bunkers, and rolling fairways. Featuring dramatic elevation changes extending across a towering ridge line, the Championship course's last nine are unlike anything in the West. Most golfers replace their club with a camera for the first shot on the back nine. The 7,315-yard course has a course rating of 73.1 and a slope of 131 from the back tees.





This 18 hole scenic masterpiece is artfully interwoven with the character and contours of Sun City Mesquite's spectacular landforms. Undulating through canyons with gently ascending and descending elevations, rugged rock outcroppings and tranquil water elements, the integrity of the land is preserved at every opportunity. The masterful design and creativity of famed golf course designer, Gary Panks, provides this Mesquite championship course the appearance of being crafted by nature, forged over time. All players will enjoy the dramatic beauty the course showcases as it meanders through the heart of the Mesquite community. Tranquil, yet infused with great drama, grand view corridors delight Mesquite residents and visitors alike. The 7,232-yard course has a course rating of 74.9 and a slope of 137 from the back tees.

  - C&S Cup Individuals (18)


Since opening in 2008, Coyote Springs Golf Club is considered by most to be Jack Nicklaus' finest desert creation! Coyote Springs Golf Club has been rated by Golf Digest in the Top 100 Greatest Public Courses and Golf Magazine's & Golfweek Magazine's Top Places You Can Play. The setting has been characterized as Nature's Cradle — a magnificent valley surrounded by majestic mountains and peaks on all four sides. Water features come into play on 11 holes, enhancing the overall aesthetic appeal. From the back tees, the 7,471-yard course has a course rating of 76.8 and a slope of 149. Bring your A game!





#### **Getting to Your Destination**

- 1) If not already on, turn on smart phone

Important - The Sand Hollow golf venue in UT is located in the Mountain Time Zone putting it 1 hour ahead of all other venues that are on Pacific Coast Time.

Important – Ignore total roundtrip time shown. Chimera to Mesquite is the longest single drive (95 minutes)

## C & S / PGA Tournament 'Partnering' Contest



Prior to the start of the Zurich Classic in New Orleans, LA, each contestant will select a 2-man team from the PGA field to be his 'partners'. Only PGA players can be selected, and those who are ranked in the top 25 of the world rankings can't be selected. The contest will include the Thursday, Friday and Saturday rounds of the ZC and the Corn & Soda Cup. Each day, the contestant's C&S points earned/lost will be combined with the PGA team score compared to par to arrive at the 'combined total' score for that day.

#### Examples:

NoMoo selects Tiger Woods and his teammate Denny McCarthy who shoots -2 in the opening round of the ZC while NoMoo wins one match and ties one match in the Thursday 2-man better ball. -2 minus 1 = -3 (NoMoo's score for Thursday)

Sticks selects Scott Stallings and his teammate Ricky Fowler who shoots +3 in the second round of the ZC while Sticks loses both matches in the 2-man better ball on Friday. +3 plus 2 = +5 (Sticks's score for Friday)

Low score for the 3 day total wins. 1st, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> places are paid. (50%, 30% & 20% of pot) (\$120, \$72, \$48) - \$20 entry fee.

Note: If the PGA team selected does not make the cut, that C&S player is eliminated.

#### **TROOP MOVEMENTS - DAY 1**

Platoon 1 – E, Otis, and Ollie leisurely get up at 8:00 am and make their way from the strip to the SW arrivals terminal at Harry Reid airport. NP gets up before the crack of dawn to drive almost 2 hours to BWI to catch his flight to Vegas where he catches up on his lost sleep. Platoon 3 – Although Jack is on the same flight as Snuffy, he has been voted off the Platoon 2 island and alights with the Pennsylvania crew who all arrive 3 minutes after Jack. Jay collects the rental van from Avis and they head to Chimera GC.

Important - The scramble will be played from the blue tees for all par 4s and black tees for all par 3 & par 5s (<6200 yards).

Rental van / car drivers (Snuffy, NoMoo and E) – the vans are already setup for pickup from Avis in your name.

After the round, we will decide if we eat at Chimera GC or get pizza at the condo. Then we go to the Hawk Ridge Condo (1.5 hour drive). E will pick up adult beverages plus childish ones like H2O and munchies on Wednesday morning before heading to Chimera GC, and everyone will get together at tournament central (E's unit) to pick the matches.

Let E know if there are specific beverages or snacks / munchies you would like him to get.
