

We will again have the "Partner With the Pros" contest. The professional golf event that corresponds to the C & S this year is the Masters in Augusta, GA.





#### Westchase Golf Club - Tampa, FL

- Day 1
  - 4-Man Scramble (18) from White Tees for par 4s and Blue tees for all others

The Westchase Golf Club is one of the premier semi-private clubs in the Tampa Bay area offering a country club atmosphere with firstclass service. Designed by renowned architect Lloyd Clifton, the 6700-yard, par 72 (from the back tees) layout winds through natural lakes, conservation areas and forest. After golfers navigate front nine shots through impressive Florida pine and palmetto trees they are then confronted by back nine challenges with lakes, wetlands. native oaks and cypress trees. The well-manicured, smooth greens - always among the best in Tampa Bay - are fair and true. The beautiful Signature Hole #3, at 212 yards from the tips is a lot to handle - all carry over water! No worries – it's a scramble.





#### Carrollwood Country Club – Tampa, FL

- Day 2
  - C&S Cup 2-man Best Ball (18)

Redesigned by Dan Maples, Carrollwood Country Club features three distinct nine holes of golf and are among the best conditioned courses in the Tampa Bay area - Pine, Cypress and Meadow with two of the three making an 18 hole championship caliber round and playing to par-36 from three sets of tees: Pine/Cypress 5821yds - 6956yds; Cypress/Meadow 5929yds -6833yds; Meadow/Pine 5768yds - 6803yds. Length off the tee is not vital at Carrollwood CC with many holes requiring shot placement and accuracy off the tee. A variety of strategically placed bunkers dot the landscape in several landing areas including devilish pot bunkers and large waste bunkers. Water hazards abut several elevated greens which are wellundulated and roll true.

# Fox Hollow Golf Club – Trinity, FL

- *Day 3* 
  - C&S Cup 2 Man Best Ball (18)

Fox Hollow Golf Club is one of the premier golf courses in Florida and was one of the last courses designed by Robert Trent Jones, Sr. who created a layout as picturesque as it is playable. Fox Hollow offers a good, fair test of golf. The par-71 championship layout features five sets of tees routing among native trees and vegetation, sparkling lakes, sand bunkers and a variety of wildlife. Fox Hollow's rolling fairways are a delightful departure from the pancake-flat layouts found elsewhere in Florida. The putting surfaces at Fox Hollow are among the smoothest, fast green complexes in the Tampa Bay area. Fox Hollow has hosted local qualifying for the U.S. Open as well as qualifiers for the Valspar Championship, the PGA Tour event held annually at Innisbrook Golf Resort.







**Important** – Ignore total roundtrip time shown. Emerald Greens to Fox Hollow is the longest drive (29 miles).

## C & S / PGA Tournament 'Partnering' Contest



Prior to the start of The Masters Tournament in Augusta, GA, each contestant will select a player from the field to be his 'partner'. Only PGA tour players can be selected, and those who are ranked in the top 25 of the world rankings can't be selected. The contest will include the Thursday, Friday and Saturday rounds of The Masters and the Corn & Soda Cup. Each day, the contestant's C&S points earned/lost will be combined with the PGA player score compared to par to arrive at the 'combined total' score for that day.

#### Examples:

NoMoo selects Denny McCarthy who shoots –2 in the opening round of the Masters while NoMoo wins one match and ties one match in the Thursday 2-man better ball. –2 minus 1 = -3 (NoMoo's score for Thursday)

Sticks selects Ricky Fowler who shoots +3 in the second round of the Masters while Sticks loses both matches in the 2-man better ball on Friday. +3 plus 2 = +5 (Sticks's score for Friday)

Low score for the 3 day total wins. 1st, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> places are paid. (50%, 30% & 20% of pot) (\$160, \$96, \$64) - \$20 entry fee.

Note: If the PGA player selected does not make the cut, that C&S player is eliminated.
