Ocean Course at Sea Pines –

- *Practice Round (18)*
- *Celebrity Appearance by
Bill Loos*

Measuring 6,906 yards from the McCumber tees with a slope of 133, the course makes extensive use of lagoons and bunkers to add interest and challenge. Mark McCumber has personally redesigned the course with emphasis on the traditional and classical principles of course design. He has built interest, challenge and strategy into the course while preserving the natural beauty of Sea Pines. The par-3 15th hole, one of the most photographed on the East Coast, is even more spectacular than before. The tee has been elevated to offer a magnificent view of the Atlantic Ocean. The new Ocean Course provides a fair but demanding round of golf amidst the beauty of Sea Pines

After a multi-million dollar reconstruction project, The Sea Pines Resort is pleased to announce Heron Point by Pete Dye.

Designed by legendary course architect Pete Dye, Heron Point is nothing short of a modern masterpiece. Fairways have been reshaped into dramatic angles and shifting elevations, while surfaces are a mix of sand, mulch, limestone, and different grasses that offer a kaleidoscope of appealing color changes.

As the second Hilton Head Island golf course at The Sea Pines Resort designed by Dye, Heron Point lives up to its prestigious reputation with challenging new features.

Harbour Town Golf Links -


- *Day 3 C & S Cup
Individuals (18)*

Measuring 6,973 yards from the Heritage tees with a slope of 146, the par-71 course is deceptively short by today's standards. But numbers tell only a small part of the story. Like the old Scottish courses of which it is reminiscent, Harbour Town Golf Links requires perfectly positioned shots, arrow-straight accuracy and unwavering consistency on the part of the player. Its tight fairways, postage-stamp greens, deep bunkers and thick rough are just a few of the challenges.

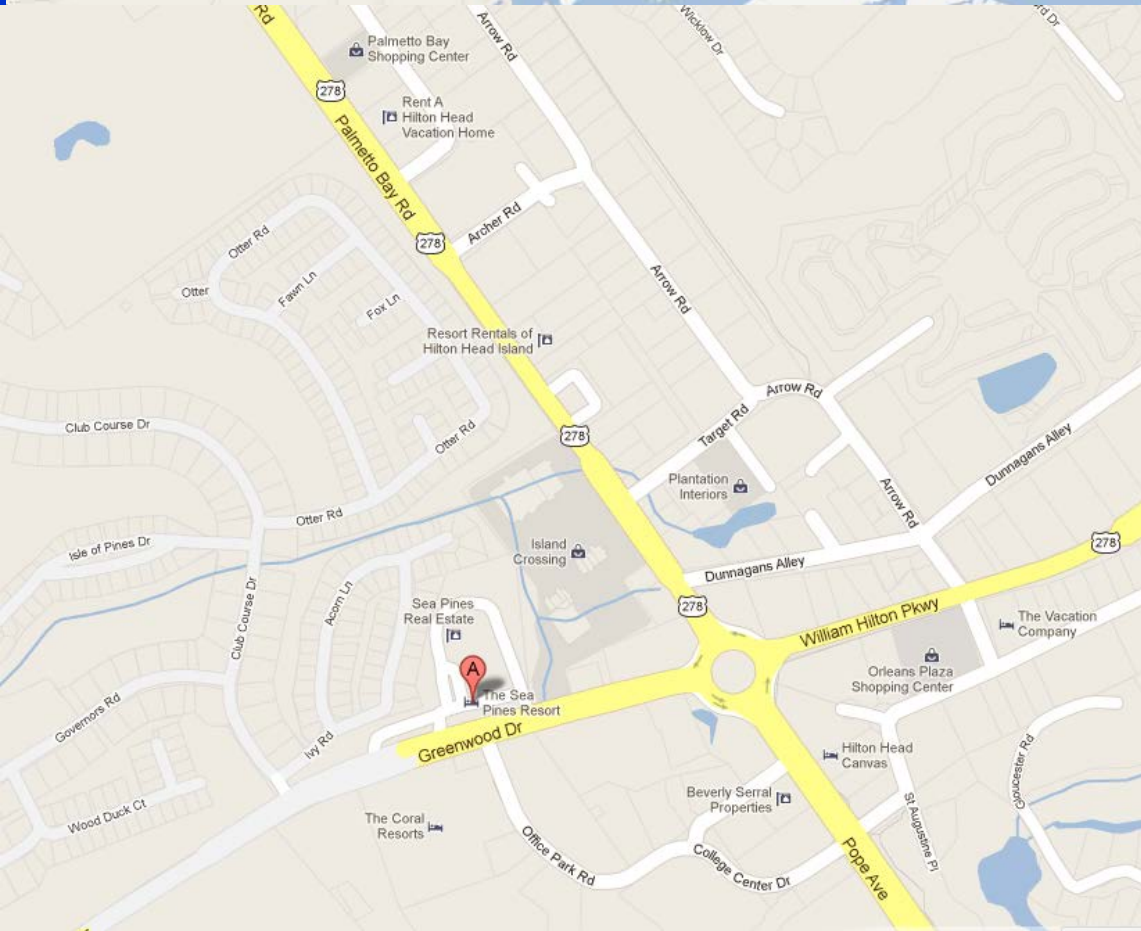

Byron Nelson

By the start of the HP Classic in New Orleans, each contestant will select a player from the ~~HPC~~ field to be his 'partner'. ~~HPC~~ players that are ranked in the top 25 of the world rankings can't be selected.

The contest will include the Thursday, Friday and Saturday rounds of the ~~HPC~~ and the Corn & Soda Cup.

Each day, the contestants C&S points earned/lost will be combined with the ~~HPC~~ player's score compared to par to arrive at the '2 man team' score for that day.

Byron Nelson

Examples:

Tan Man selects Fred Funk who shoots -2 in the opening round of the ~~HPC~~ while Tan Man wins one match and ties one match in the Thursday 2-man scrambles.

-2 minus 1 = -3 (Tan Man's score for Thursday)

Dale selects Jay Haas who shoots +3 in the second round of the HPC while Dale loses both matches in the 2-man best ball on Friday. +3 plus 2 = +5 (Dale's score for Friday)

4th and 5th

Low score for the 3 day total wins. 1st, 2nd and 3rd places are paid. (~~50%, 30% & 20% of pot~~) **(\$140, \$70, \$50, \$35, \$25)**

\$20 entry fee.
