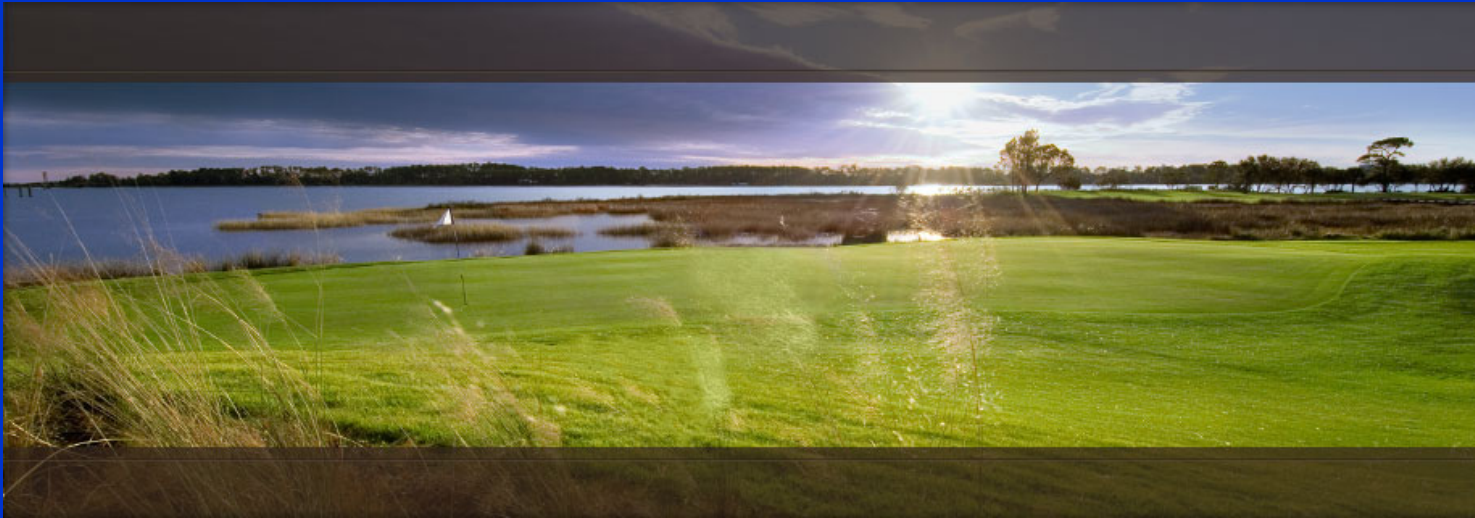

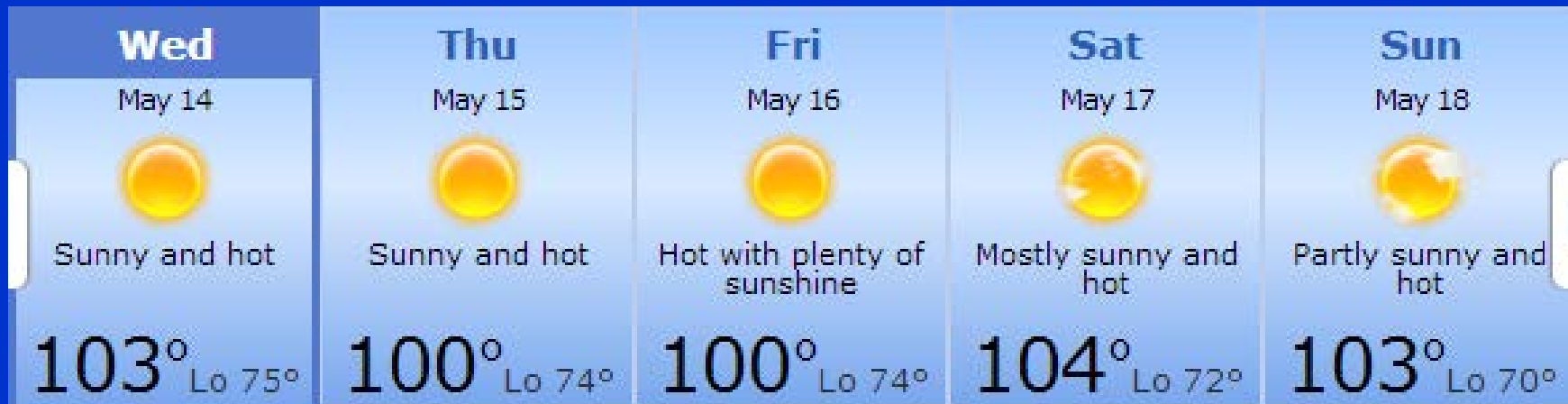

The Classic Club —

- *Practice Round (18)*

This 18-hole par-72, 7,305 yard championship Arnold Palmer-designed course will offer a variety of tee options, appealing to players at all levels of the game - from novice players to those on the PGA TOUR. The course offers spacious, sculptured fairways, 30 acres of lakes & streams, rolling terrain with several elevated tees featuring a core design with pine, olive and pepperwood trees, offset by flowering bushes, shrubs and pine straw ground cover, all playing off of the surrounding mountains and vistas that are exclusive to the Coachella Valley. All this combined makes for an incredibly beautiful golf experience. In January 2007 the Classic Club served as the host of the PGA TOUR Bob Hope Chrysler Classic. Today this championship course holds the title "The #1 public course in Palm Springs for 2009 per Desert Golf Magazine."

Desert Willow Firecliff -

- *Day 1 C & S Cup
2-Man Scrambles
(18 holes @ 2x9)*

Since opening day the Firecliff course has received numerous awards and recognition for its unique and challenging design. Recently selected by Golf Digest as one of "The Places To Play", this tournament tested layout is one of only three courses in California and one of the best 50 in the United States to receive this designation in terms of conditioning. The course features more than 100 bunkers, expansive desert areas, undulating greens and 5 holes that bring water into play.

Desert Willow Mountainview –

•Day 1 C & S 4-man Scramble (9)



Opened just 11 short months after Firecliff, Mountain View is designed more as a resort-type course with wider fairways and limited desert waste areas. But appearances can be deceiving, as Mountain View is rated just slightly less difficult than its predecessor.

Somewhat forgiving fairways, 98 well-placed bunkers, sloping greens, and 7 water features require golfers to incorporate their best course management skills to avoid trouble lurking adjacent to virtually every fairway and green.

The North Course at Golf Club at Terra Lago, host to half the Skins Game through 2004, is a superb layout with a tremendously exciting closing stretch of holes. The back nine of this 7,123-yard layout offers a variety of risk-reward opportunities, making it an ideal closing stretch for the drama of the Skins Game. The underrated front side weaves through surprisingly rolling terrain and three crystal clear lakes, offering great views of San Geronio Mountain and the rest of the Coachella Valley.

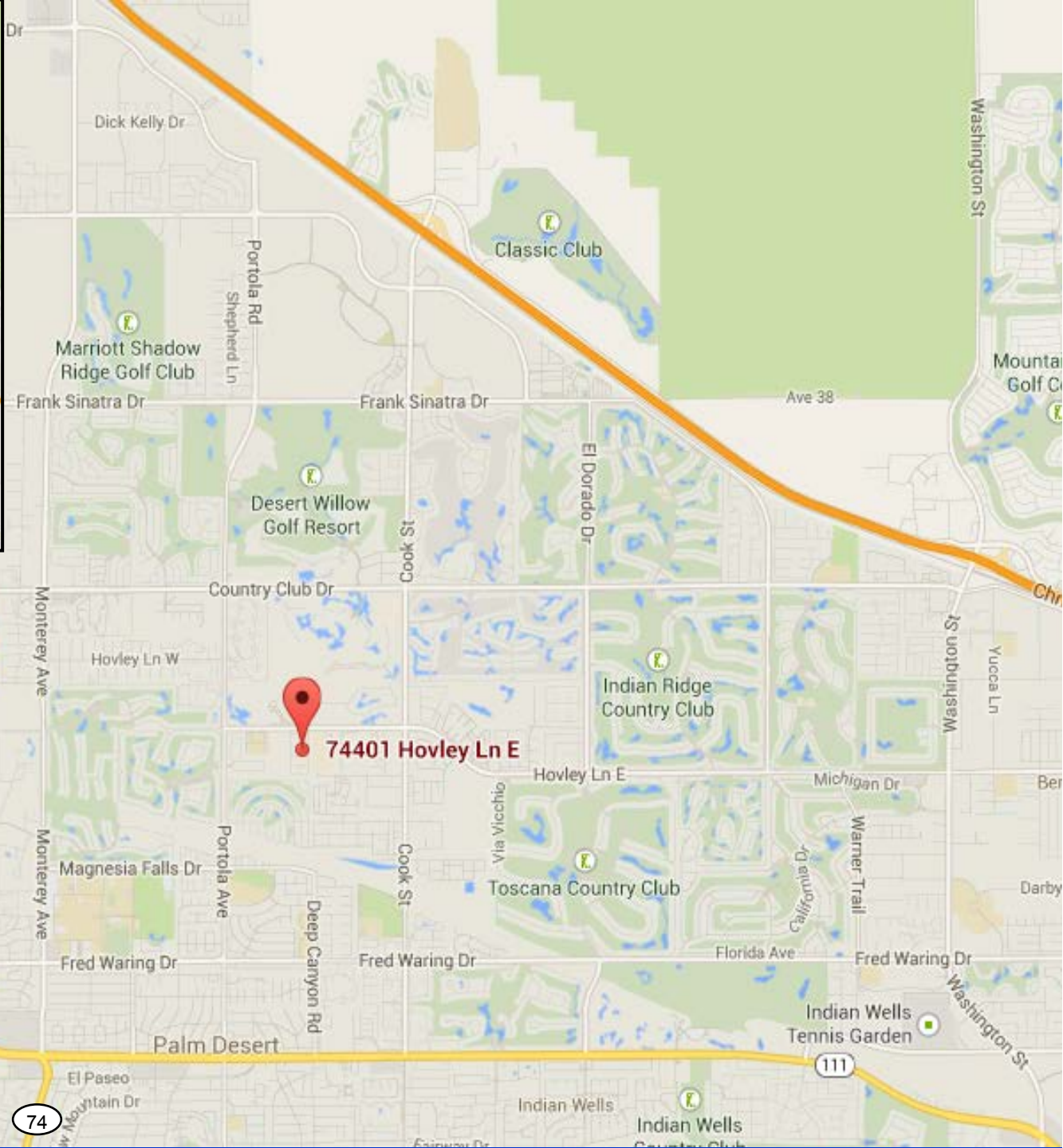
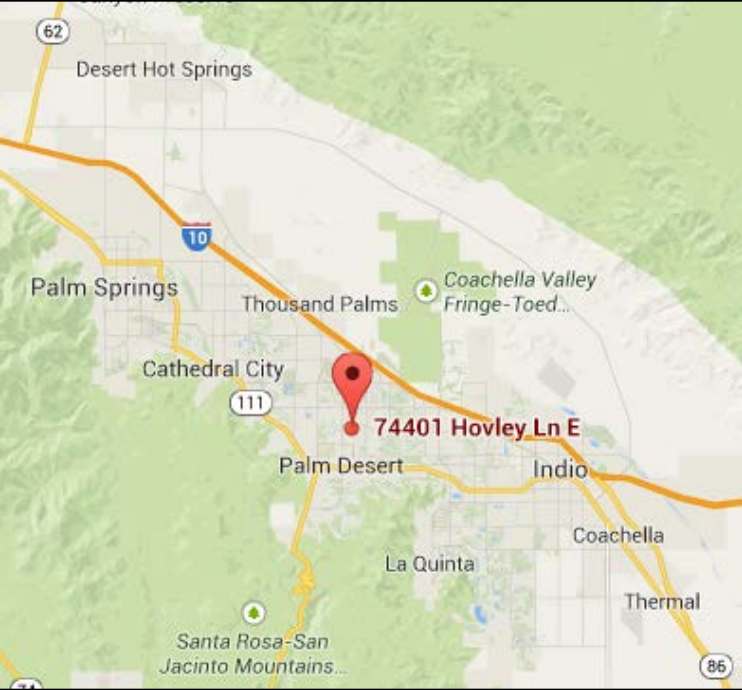

The contest will include the Thursday, Friday and Saturday rounds of the ~~HPC~~ and the Corn & Soda Cup.

Each day, the contestants C&S points earned/lost will be combined with the ~~HPC~~ player's score compared to par to arrive at the '2 man team' score for that day.

Examples:

Tan Man selects Fred Funk who shoots -2 in the opening round of the ~~HPC~~ while Tan Man wins one match and ties one match in the Thursday 2-man scrambles.

-2 minus 1 = -3 (Tan Man's score for Thursday)

Dale selects Jay Haas who shoots +3 in the second round of the HPC while Dale loses both matches in the 2-man best ball on Friday. +3 plus 2 = +5 (Dale's score for Friday)

4th and 5th

Low score for the 3 day total wins. 1st, 2nd and 3rd places are paid. (~~50%, 30% & 20% of pot~~) **(\$140, \$70, \$50, \$35, \$25)**
