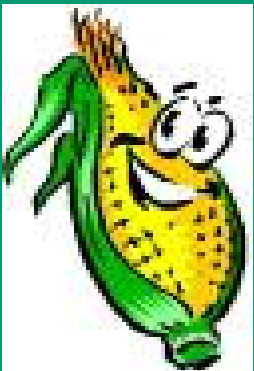

Downtown Fort Lauderdale

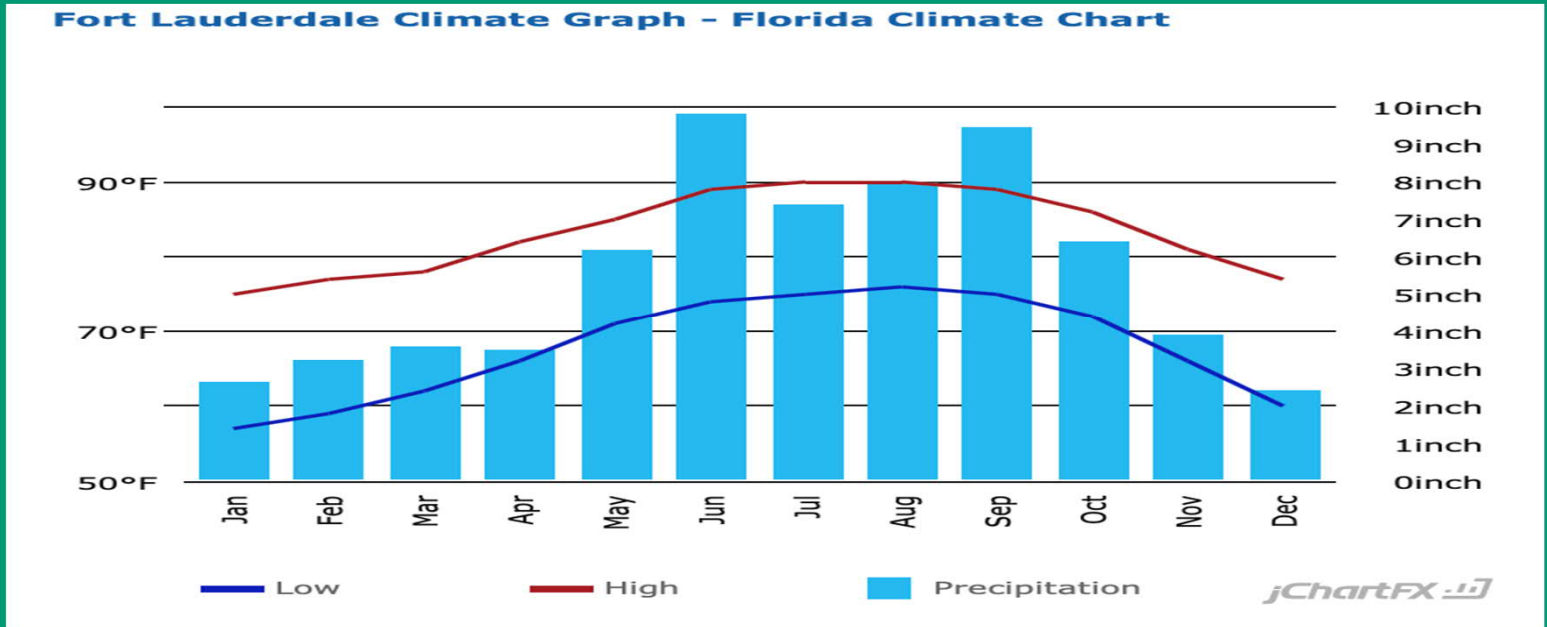



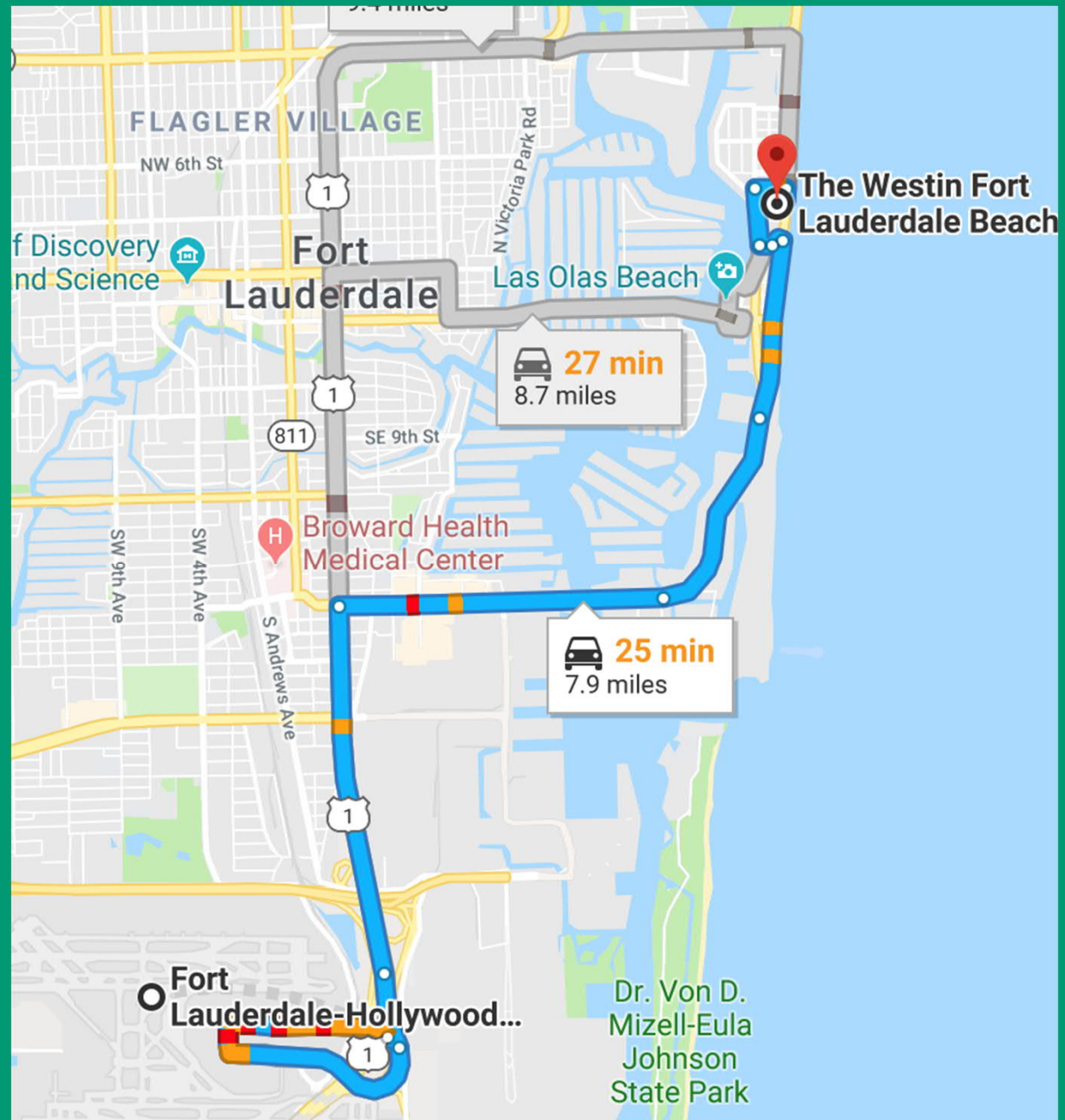

## Getting to Your Destination

- 1) If not already on, turn on smart phone
  - 1) Important, if battery charge is low, plug it into car charger.
- 2) Call up Google Maps (or any decent GPS navigation system)
- 3) Put in one of the following destinations –
  - a) **Deer Creek GC at 2801 Deer Creek Country Club Blvd., Deerfield Beach, FL 33442**
  - b) **Jacaranda GC at 9200 West Broward Blvd., Plantation, FL 33324**
  - c) **Parkland GC at 10045 Old Club Road, Parkland, FL 33076**
  - d) **Plantation Preserve GC at 7050 W Broward Blvd., Plantation, FL 33317**
- 4) Use your current location as the starting point
- 5) Do the search, and follow the directions
  - a) Note that this same process can be used for other destinations



All golf venues are around 25 minutes from the airport / resort

# C & S / PGA Championship 'Partnering' Contest



Prior to the start of the PGA Championship in Farmingdale, NY, each contestant will select a player from the PGA field to be his 'partner'. PGA players that are ranked in the top 25 of the world rankings can't be selected. The contest will include the Thursday, Friday and Saturday rounds of the PGA and the Corn & Soda Cup. Each day, the contestants C&S points earned/lost will be combined with the PGA player's score compared to par to arrive at the '2 man team' score for that day.

## Examples:

Tan Man selects Adam Scott who shoots  $-2$  in the opening round of the PGA while Tan Man wins one match and ties one match in the Thursday 2-man better ball.  $-2$  minus 1 =  $-3$  (Tan Man's score for Thursday)

Sticks selects Brandt Snedeker who shoots  $+3$  in the second round of the PGA while Sticks loses both matches in the 2-man best ball on Friday.  $+3$  plus 2 =  $+5$  (Sticks's score for Friday)

Low score for the 3 day total wins. 1st, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> places are paid. (50%, 30% & 20% of pot) (\$160, \$96, \$72) - \$20 entry fee.

Note: If the PGA player selected does not make the cut, that C&S player is eliminated.

## TROOP MOVEMENTS - DAY 1

**P1 – Jack wakes up, finding Snatch and DC snuggled in bed with him, and hustles everyone out of the house before his wife finds out. Jack drives them to Deer Creek GC remembering to bring essentials (liquor, beer, snacks) that he bought the day before.**

**P2 – Sven picks up rental car and goes to Deer Creek GC.**

**P3 – Schnak picks up rental car and 1 player. They then go to Deer Creek GC with Schnak talking the whole way there.**

**P4 – Iced Tea picks up rental van and 2 players. They then go to Deer Creek GC.**

**P5 – Snuffy picks up rental van and 3 players. They then go to Deer Creek GC with Tanman singing the whole way there (in between love / hate spats with Algae).**

**P6 – Arriving late Wed. and missing the 4-man scramble:**

P7 – Wingman (E's brother in law) drives from his home to Deer Creek GC.

The scramble will be played from the white tees (6333 yards). The teams that have Ollie and Sticks as a missing teammate are short 1 player. These teams will have a player take 2 shots, alternating in succession, with the other players.

**Rental van / car drivers – it is your responsibility to rent the vehicle. Do not upgrade!**

- **Rental vans need capacity for at least 4 players with clubs and luggage.**
- **Rental cars need capacity for at least 3 players with clubs and luggage.**
