• 4-Man Scramble (18) – Serpent Tees The 6,906-yard layout boasts forgiving fairways and a playable desert landscape which provides a fair challenge from any set of tees. The natural terrain and unparalleled views of the Las Vegas Strip make Chimera Golf Club an incredible place to enjoy a round. Begin your day warming up on the driving range with unobstructed views of the Strip, Downtown Vegas, and snow-capped Mt. Charleston before hitting the course. Depending on the day's winds, there are potentially reachable par 5's and two drivable par 4's which add a risk-reward element few courses can match. The picturesque par 3's, firm & fast greens, extensive bunkering, elaborate water features, and pure fairways make Chimera Golf Club the "hidden oasis" in Las Vega

Bear's Best GC –

• Day 2 •C&S Cup 2-man Best Ball (18)

Located in the exclusive Ridges neighborhood of Summerlin, Bear's Best is a public course focused on providing the best possible Las Vegas golf experience. It was voted "Best Places to Play" by Golf Digest and "Best Golf Course in Las Vegas" by the Las Vegas Review Journal.

Jack Nicklaus selected 18 holes from his more than 200 course designs worldwide and put them into one extraordinary round of golf. Four of the holes are replicas from Desert Mountain in Scottsdale, but also features holes from Nicklaus' Spain and Mexico work. The most truly unique aspect of the course is the black-sand bunkers on the fourth and 11th holes, replicas of Nicklaus' design in Anaconda, Mont. The bunkers lie in stark contrast to the white-sand bunkers around the rest of the course.

Rio Secco Golf Club –

• Day 3

• C&S Cup 2 Man Best Ball (18)

The Rees Jones-designed golf course at Rio Secco Golf Club, rated 4½ out of 5 Stars by Golf Digest, unfolds over the rugged high desert foothills overlooking Las Vegas. The unique location and exceptional design combine to deliver one of the finest golf experiences in the game. The front nine is highlighted by several holes routed through the club's namesake, which means "Dry River" in Portuguese, flanked by steep canyon walls. The back nine begins with a climb to a plateau featuring commanding views of The Strip and the entire Las Vegas valley below, and the finishing holes amble up, down and along a series rocky desert ridges.


The Lexington Course at Revere G.C., rated 4 1/2 stars by Golf Digest, is the first of two Troon Golf-managed courses at Revere and opened April, 17, 1999, on the anniversary of Revere's famous Midnight Ride. The Billy Casper-Greg Nash design plays to par 72 and 7,143 yards from the tips, but four sets of tees makes it playable for everyone. As golfers wind around the course and the elevation changes, desert foliage and dramatic Vegas views captivate. On just about every tee box, you've got great views of the Strip or the course.



Getting to Your Destination

- 1) If not already on, turn on smart phone
 - 1) Important, if battery charge is low, plug it into car charger.
- 2) Call up Google Maps (or any decent GPS navigation system)
- 3) Put in one of the following destinations
 - a) Chimera Golf Club at 901 Olivia Pkwy, Henderson NV 89011
 - b) Bear's Best GC at 11111 W.
 Flamingo Rd., Las Vegas, NV 89135
 - c) Rio Secco GC at 851 Grand Hills Drive, Henderson, NV 89052
 - d) Revere at Anthem, Lexington GC at 2600 Hampton Rd, Henderson, NV 89052
- 4) Use your current location as the starting point
- 5) Do the search, and follow the directions
 - a) Note that this same process can be used for other destinations

All golf venues are around 25 minutes from the airport / resort



C & S / WF Championship 'Partnering' Contes



Prior to the start of the Wells Fargo Championship in Charlotte, each contestant will select a player from the WFC field to be his 'partner'. WFC players that are ranked in the top 25 of the world rankings can't be selected. The contest will include the Thursday, Friday and Saturday rounds of the WFC and the Corn & Soda Cup. Each day, the contestants C&S points earned/lost will be combined with the WFC player's score compared to par to arrive at the '2 man team' score for that day.

Examples:

Tan Man selects Adam Scott who shoots -2 in the opening round of the WFC while Tan Man wins one match and ties one match in the Thursday 2-man better ball. -2 minus 1 = -3 (Tan Man's score for Thursday)

Sticks selects Brandt Snedeker who shoots +3 in the second round of the WFC while Sticks looses both matches in the 2-man best ball on Friday. +3 plus 2 = +5 (Sticks's score for Friday)

Low score for the 3 day total wins. 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places are paid. (50%, 30% & 20% of pot) (\$120, \$72, \$48) - \$20 entry fee.

Note: If the WFC player selected does not make the cut, that C&S player is eliminated.
