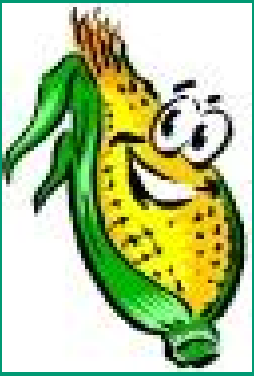

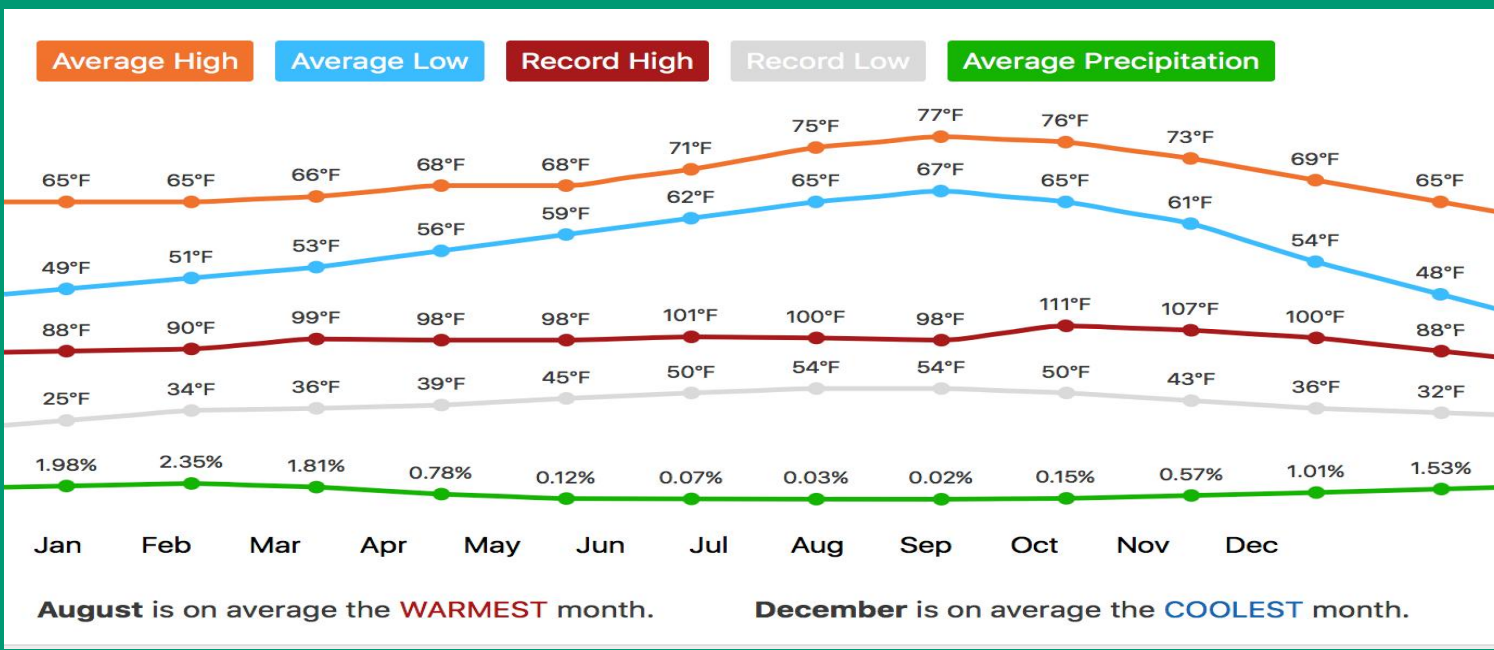

The 27-hole championship Steele Canyon Golf Club was personally designed by Gary Player with respect and appreciation for the natural beauty of the terrain. Each of the three nines offers a distinct environment and type of play for all levels of golfers. The rugged Canyon Course's dramatic shot making challenges and breathtaking elevations are balanced by the Ranch Course's winding fairways through the fields of a working ranch, and the Vineyard course's beautiful woodlands, streams and working vineyards stretching along the valley floor. As one of Southern California's finest golf clubs, Steele Canyon has been awarded Golf Digest's Four and a Half Star Rating, one of only three golf clubs so honored in San Diego County.

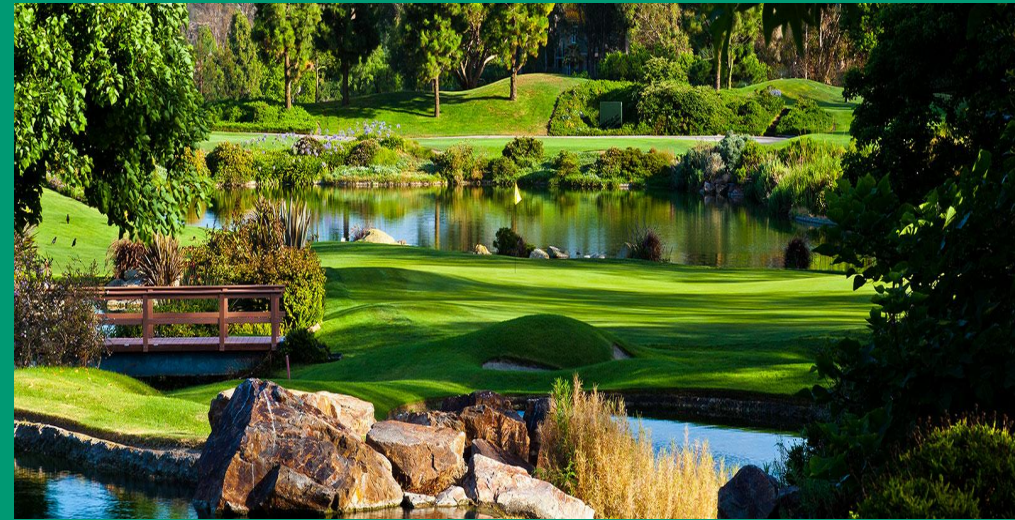

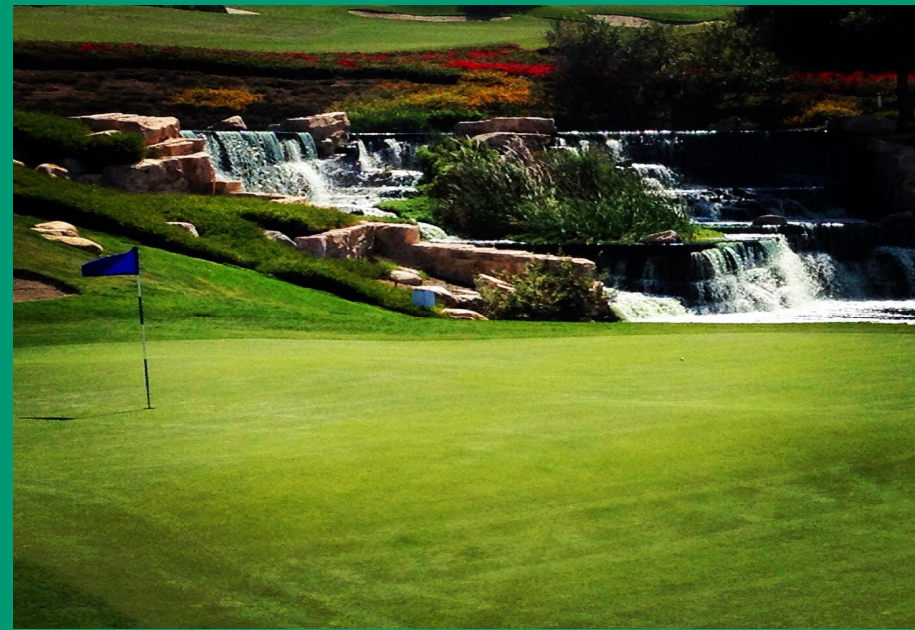

Located in North San Diego County, the Crossings at Carlsbad is an 18-hole, 6,835 yard championship golf course designed by Greg Nash. With beautiful Pacific Ocean to the West and foothills rising to the East, this course offers visitors a magnificent setting in a relaxed California Coastal environment. The course is named for the five bridges - or crossings - that were designed into the layout to meet existing environmental and topographic conditions.



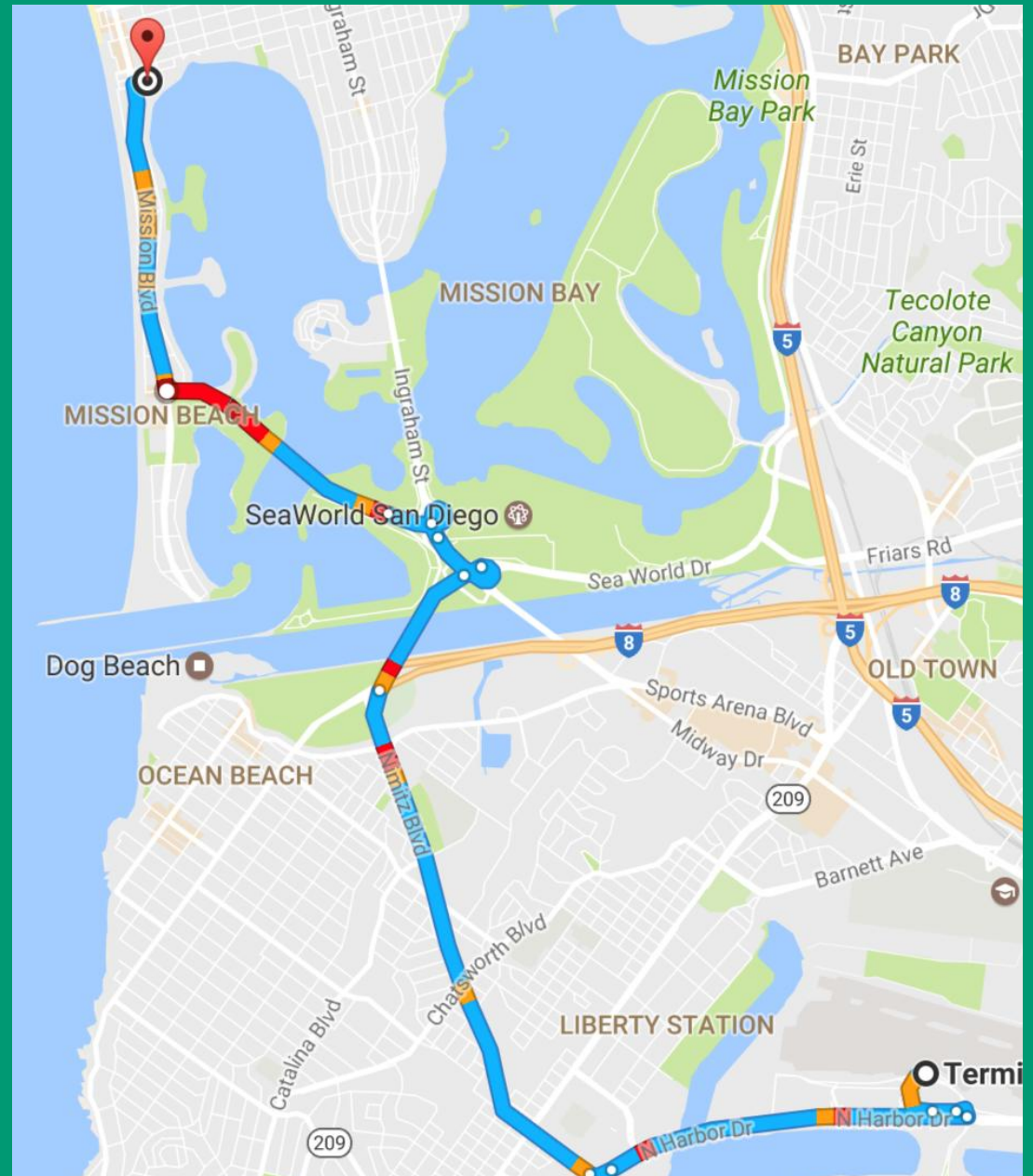

## Getting to Your Destination

- 1) If not already on, turn on smart phone (not Geese's).
  - 1) Important, if battery charge is low, plug it into car charger.
- 2) Call up Google Maps (or any decent GPS navigation system)
- 3) Put in one of the following destinations –
  - a) **Catamaran Resort at 3999 Mission Blvd, San Diego, CA**
  - b) **Steele Canyon GC at 3199 Stonefield Dr, Jumal, CA**
  - c) **Maderas GC at 17750 Old Coach Rd, Poway, CA**
  - d) **Park Hyatt Aviara GC at 7100 Aviara Resort Drive, Carlsbad, CA**
  - e) **The Crossings at Carlsbad GC, at 5800 The Crossings Dr, Carlsbad, CA**
- 4) Use your current location as the starting point
- 5) Do the search, and follow the directions
  - a) Note that this same process can be used for other destinations

**C & S / ~~HP Classic~~ 'Partnering' Contest**  
**ATT Byron Nelson**

**ATT BN**

By the start of the ~~HP Classic in New Orleans~~, each contestant will select a player from the ~~HPC~~ field to be his 'partner'. ~~HPC~~ players that are ranked in the top 25 of the world rankings can't be selected.

The contest will include the Thursday, Friday and Saturday rounds of the ~~HPC~~ and the Corn & Soda Cup. **ATT BN**

Each day, the contestants C&S points earned/lost will be combined with the ~~ATT BN~~ player's score compared to par to arrive at the '2 man team' score for that day.

*Examples:*

*Tan Man selects Fred Funk who shoots -2 in the opening round ~~of the HPC~~ while Tan Man wins one match and ties one match in the Thursday 2-man scrambles.  
-2 minus 1 = -3 (Tan Man's score for Thursday)*

*Dale selects Jay Haas who shoots +3 in the second round ~~of the HPC~~ while Dale loses both matches in the 2-man best ball on Friday. +3 plus 2 = +5 (Dale's score for Friday)*

**4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup>**

Low score for the 3 day total wins. 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> places are paid. (~~50%, 30% & 20% of pot~~) **(\$140, \$70, \$50, \$35, \$25)**

\$20 entry fee.

**ATT BN**

Note: If the ~~HPC~~ player selected does not make the cut, that C&S player is eliminated.
